¹ ASTM F2623 PE-RT tubing is listed as an equivalent option to ASTM F876 PEX for non-potable applications per CSA B214.

² Plastic Pipe Institute (PPI) Technical Report-4 listings were used for these calculations. Most PEX tubing are rated to 160 psi at 73°F (23°C).

³ VIPERTTM (PE-RT) Radiant is manufactured with a Specific Gravity of 0.93, to bend easily for more controlled installations, reducing time, effort, and the risk of kinking.

⁴ PE-RT exhibits more flexibility compared to PEX-a and PEX-b. VIPERT's improved stress relaxation reduces the tubing's tendency to revert to its original coil, unlike PEX.
